### Remember who you Represent

Titus 3:1-2 | 1 Peter 2:13-15 | Rom 13:1-2 | 1 Tim 2:1-2 | Acts 5:29 | Jer 29:4-7

- a. Don't get caught up in **FIGHTING** the authorities
- b. We are to change **SOCIETY** with the power of the Gospel.

### Remember your Chains

Titus 3:3 | Eph. 2:1-4 | 2 Cor. 4:4 | Prov. 14:30

- c. We are to treat non-Christians with **TENDERNESS & GRACE** because we were like them.
- d. Are you angry at **SINNERS** for acting like **SINNERS**?
- e. Remembering our former life builds **HUMILITY** in us.
- f. If God can **CHANGE** us, He can change others.

### Remember Your Savior

Titus 3:4-7 | Romans 2:4 | Eph. 2:8-9

- g. He saved us from the **PENALTY** of sin.
- h. He is saving us from the **POWER** of sin
- i. He will save us from the **PRESENCE** of sin.

### Remember Your Mission

Titus 3:8 | Eph 6:10 | 1 Peter 2:11-12

- j. Live in Such a way that
  - i. no one will **BLAME** God's word
  - ii. **ENEMIES** will not find anything bad to say
  - iii. teaching about God is **ATTRACTIVE**
