The Bible Doesn't Say That: You Can't Judge Me Or My Lifestyle

Matthew 7:1-6

Jesus' words do not mean a universal acceptance of any lifestyle, attitude, or behavior

Judge= to sentence, to condemn, to damn

'Judge not' forbids pronouncing another person **<u>guilty</u>** before God, thus condemning them. We are not THE **JUDGE**!

We are not to consider that we are spiritual & morally **<u>superior</u>** than others

We are to judge for **identification** and for **restoration** (*Matt. 7:6, Rom 16:17, Gal. 6:1*)

There is a difference between judging wrongly, and accountability

We are called to show unconditional love, but not unconditional approval

The **<u>Standard</u>** is God's Word

We are primarily to call people <u>upward</u> and show there is a better way to <u>live</u>

Judgment begins in the House of **<u>God</u>** (1 Pet 4:17)

People will **know** us by how we judge (Matt. 7:2, Matthew 7:12)

Jesus is emphasizing to evaluate ourselves first (Matt. 7:3-5)

 \rightarrow The day of **judgment** has not happened yet, we all still have grace
